Program Summary

Redeemed Living is a residential program for addicted males over the age of 18 years old lasting six to nine months and is designed in four phases. Residents progress at their own pace, earning their way to the next level by meeting certain goals. Close personal guidance is given each step of the way. At the core of our program is spiritual development through participation in Christian activities. Redeemed Living's program focuses on growing a man spiritually while addressing the specifics of addiction. We seek to grow a man in his relationship to God while gaining successful employment and working a recovery program. Our primary goal is for a man to grow spiritually, therefore freeing him from the grip of drugs and alcohol.

Fees

Funding for Redeemed Living comes from rent, private donations, and corporate donations.

Resident fees are \$200.00 per week per person for regular residents. Upon admission, three weeks fees are due in advance (\$600.00). This covers your first two week's rent and your last week's rent. This deposit is non-refundable – your last week with us will be paid for. Fees are to be paid on Sunday of each week and cover Sunday – Saturday of the next week. IF you go on pass you will be required to pay rent on Friday before you leave to go on pass. Once any monies have been paid to Redeemed Living they become the property of such and will not be refunded for any reason.

Fees may be paid by cash or money order.

Redeemed Living will supply all needed household supplies. A maximum of \$50 of your weekly rent will be budgeted for food. Once weekly, the resident leader and designate of Redeemed Living will buy all food needed to satisfy the set menu and all snack and lunch food for the week. The food budget is a household budget, not an individual budget. It is not each resident's \$50 budget, it is a household budget based on the number of residents in the house.

Also, weekly alcohol and drug screens are included.

Redeemed Living reserves the right to change, amend, or waive a fee or regulation if the leaders of Redeemed Living deem necessary.



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Phases of Recovery

At no time will residents leave the property without prior permission from Senior man or Director and must check back in with the same staff member when returning. Senior man/Director is to know where you are at ALL times! There is an expressed permission to leave for scheduled activities and to return immediately from such. If the resident is not going to return immediately, the resident must have permission. Clients will be required to have Life360 on there phone at all times for accountability purposes.

Phase 1

New residents enter Phase 1 of our four-phase program. To move to the next phase, a resident must have been in the program for 4 weeks and have shown that he is responsible. Phase 1 residents are not allowed weekend passes. Phase 1 residents must have the director's approval to go anywhere except to scheduled activities. To leave the property residents must have someone in Phase 2 or higher with them or an approved family or staff member. To complete this phase a resident must have an approved sponsor/mentor they are actively working with and a full-time job. Phase 1 is a probationary phase in which a client's continued residency is conditional upon showing a willingness to follow the rules and work the program. Resident must have established a Home church, attend church on Sunday mornings and one other church meeting, Attend Tuesday night bible study, and establish and attend one other support group meeting throughout the week.

Phase 2

In order to advance to Phase 2, residents must have a full-time job and a sponsor/mentor and be in the program at least 4 weeks. The resident must have been responsible and have complied with the rules of the program. Phase 2 residents can request a pass with an Approved family member on the 1st and 3rd weekends of the month that do not have scheduled work activities. These passes do not change for months with 5 weekends. It is still only 1st and 3rd weekends for passes. Residents cannot have passes for 2 consecutive weekends. Residents can leave the property but must be with another resident and be back on the property by his curfew of 10pm. Leaving the property must still be approved by the director. Resident must have established a Home church, attend church on Sunday mornings and one other church meeting, Attend Tuesday night bible study, and establish and attend one other support group meeting throughout the week.

Phase 3



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In order to enter Phase 3 the resident must have a stable full time job, must be in the program for at least 3 months, must be current in all fees, must have begun to build an outside support group, must have a progress assessment with director, and must have a record of compliance with rules and regulations without any major infractions. Residents may request a pass on 1st and 3rd weekends. A resident cannot request a pass for consecutive weekends. A resident can leave the property by himself, but must be back by his curfew of 10:00pm. Resident must have established a Home church, attend church on Sunday mornings and one other church meeting, Attend Tuesday night bible study, and establish and attend one other support group meeting throughout the week.

Phase 4

Residents must continue to build on their recovery, working with their sponsor/mentor and continuing to build their outside support group. Residents can apply for weekend passes every weekend unless there are scheduled work activities. Residents have a curfew of 10:00pm every night of the week unless there is prior approval from the director in certain instances. If resident leaves with other residents, all must be back by the earliest curfew of those leaving together. Residents in this phase must begin planning, with staff, where they are going to live when they leave redeemed living. Also, must be developing a plan of action in recovery. Must write a letter telling why they feel they are ready for phase 4 and goals for phase 4. To graduate a resident must complete phase 4. Resident must have established a Home church, attend church on Sunday mornings and one other church meeting, Attend Tuesday night bible study, and establish and attend one other support group meeting throughout the week.

Upon completing one phase, residents begin to work on the next phase.



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Application for Admission

I understand that Redeemed Living is Faith (Christian) Based, family oriented, residential program utilizing Church attendance, Twelve Step Programs, Different styles of Bible Studies and minor counseling by staff. This is an ACCOUNTABILITY PROGRAM!

I understand that Redeemed Living is a non-medical facility and does not provide nursing care nor issue prescription medications. If any medical services become necessary Redeemed Living does not agree to provide these services nor is Redeemed Living responsible for providing such services.

Admission Criteria:

1. 18 years of age or older
2. Preferably have completed and 6-week minimum Inpatient program.
3. Must be physically and mentally capable of full time employment.
4. Must be free of communicable disease(s).
5. Must be a Christian with a strong desire to grow spiritually and mentally.
6. Must be willing to follow all rules and regulations and cooperate with staff.

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Rules and Regulations

By signing the following document, I, _____, understand and have agreed to the all previous terms discussed in this packet and understand that all rules, regulations, and requirements may be changed or updated in writing at any time. In the event that Redeemed Living decides to alter the rules / regulations a copy of a new packet will be given to me by 7:00 p.m. of any given day, and I will have until 7:00 a.m. the following day to sign the packet and turn into the director or proper administration, or I will be discharged from the program. Redeemed Living Inc. is an **accountability program**. These rules/regulations, are not set up to make your lives difficult or miserable, they are set up for ACOUNTABILTY PURPOSES ONLY!!!!!!

1. All residents will have to follow all local, state, and federal laws.
2. Residents will have to follow all regulations and stipulations of his probation / parole.
3. Residents will have to actively seek full time employment between the hours of 6:00 AM and 6:00 PM - Monday thru Friday. Saturday work to be approved on a case-by-case basis.
4. Must maintain full time, daytime approved employment. At no time is a resident allowed to quit a job without permission and discussion with director. Redeemed Living will provide transportation to and from work when necessary for the first 30 days at no charge, after 30 days a fee will be discussed and agreed upon for transportation until you are able to find reliable transportation. Assistance in finding a job is available, but the effort must be made by the resident.
5. Residents must be up by 7am on all workdays unless having prior approval. Any resident not working on a weekday is allowed to take a nap between 12:00 PM and 2:00 PM. Before and after that the residents are expected to help with assigned duties around the Redeemed Living property.
6. Attendance: All residents are required to attend all meetings to include Sunday morning church and week night meetings as a group. You must be at all group activities on time. If you miss any meeting you must make it up that week. Sunday morning and Tuesday night bible study are non negotiables. You are allowed two missed meetings per month but must make them up same week. (Ex. If you miss Wednesday night church, you can make it up on Thursday by going to CR. Or if you miss your Monday AA meeting you can make it up on Thursday)
7. Curfew: 10:00PM
8. No visitors are allowed in the residence at any time without prior approval from administration. Residents are held responsible for the behavior of their guests.



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9. All residents will conduct themselves in a manner not to disrupt others (no loud music, television, shouting, etc.).
10. No music except Christian music.
11. **No pornography** is allowed at any time in a resident's possession or in a resident's belongings, to include in their phone. **We will perform random phone checks to assure no one is looking at pornography if your history is deleted you will be assumed to be guilty.**
12. No addictive substances will be consumed by any resident at any time. (This will result in immediate discharge)
13. All medicines must be approved by administration. This includes over the counter medicines.
14. No television between 9am-4pm on weekdays without the director's approval, except on holidays. Banned channels (at no time are you to watch these channels) MTV, VH1, CMT, BET. Any show or movie with excessive vulgar language, excessive drinking or drug usage, sex, any nudity, is not tolerated. Senior man has full discretion.
15. No cigarette smoking is allowed inside the house. Smoking is only allowed in the backyard and butts disposed of in a container. No smoking under porches or garage under any circumstances (even if it's raining!) No smoking of vapor cigarettes, E cigs, etc. allowed in the house. Dipping is allowed in the house but must use a bottle to spit in and thrown away before a new bottle is used. Do not leave multiple spit bottles laying around the house or in your bedroom!
16. Residents are responsible for keeping houses neat and clean at all times. Beds will be made in the morning within 15 minutes of waking up. This includes weekends and holidays. Staff will make routine inspections. Bible, lamps, alarm clocks, and phone are the only thing allowed on your night stand or dresser. Clothes neatly folded or hung and put away. Dishes are to be washed and kitchen cleaned immediately after using. Floors are to be cleaned twice weekly (vacuumed, mopped, swept). Bathrooms to be cleaned once a week. If you use it, put it away. If you dirty it, clean it. Weekly chores list will be posted so that it will be known whose responsibility it is to clean which parts of the house. Household chores are to be shared equally!
17. Residents are required to bathe daily and to keep themselves groomed neatly. Clothes are required throughout the day at all times. No sitting around without a shirt on. The only piercings allowed are if you already have your ears pierced. No new piercings as a resident. All piercings must be taken

out except ears upon moving in. If your ears are pierced with gauges you cannot continue to make them bigger and you cannot gauge your ears if they



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- are not already that way. No baggy clothing or having inappropriate messages on it. No headphones allowed around house or in any group meetings.
18. Weekend and Saturday passes are granted with an approved family member or sponsor only. Pass request must be submitted by Wednesday at 8:00 PM.
 - a. Phase 1: No weekend passes. Saturday passes will be from 10:00 AM – 4:00 PM.
 - b. Phase 2 & 3: May be allowed 1st and 3rd full weekend from after work Friday to Sunday 5:00 PM. Saturday Passes for Phase 2- 10:00 AM -6:00 PM and Phase 3- 10:00 AM – 8:00 PM.
 - c. Phase 4: Allowed weekend passes 3 weekends of the month from after work Friday to Sunday 5:00 PM. Saturday passes are from 10:00 AM – 10:00PM
 19. Any resident that goes on a pass without approval will be discharged.
 20. Rent must be paid before you leave on a pass.
 21. It is the responsibility of the resident to immediately report to the director and submit to drug and alcohol testing. Failure to report for a drug test and breathalyzing will result in discharge.
 22. No dating is allowed while a resident at Redeemed Living without prior approval from the director. Under no circumstances will PHYSICAL relationships be tolerated, including kissing. NO Dating websites are allowed to be on anyone's phone or looked at. Failure to follow these guidelines will result in loss of pass weekends for 2 months and/or result in losing your phone privileges at night.
 23. No gambling is allowed. This includes scratch off or lottery tickets.
 24. No pets allowed.
 25. No personal computers are allowed. Tablets and phones are allowed but director must have passwords at all times for accountability purposes.
 26. No weapons, violence, abusive behavior, or threatening will be tolerated.
 27. No profanity is allowed.
 28. Resident must report any infectious disease or illness to the director.
 29. Resident agrees to conduct himself in a manner conducive to recovery, discipline, safety, and health.
 30. Destruction of Redeemed Living property shall constitute ground for discharge. At the very minimum residents will pay for the damaged property.
 31. All fees must be paid by Sunday at 7:00 PM.
 32. No resident will be allowed to stay in the program 2 weeks past due of payment. No refunds of payments for any reason.
 33. **NO CELL PHONES** are allowed to be used during church or any other group meetings.
 34. All residents are required to participate in work detail.
 35. No use of cell phones after 11:00 PM including, talking, texting, internet, music, etc.



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- 36. No fraternization with former residents that did not complete the program.
- 37. No violation of other resident's confidentiality at any time.
- 38. Max budget of \$50 per resident for groceries. This will be a combined budget and the house leader will shop for the whole house after everyone coming to an agreement on meals and groceries. No sodas, energy drinks, etc. are to be purchased with grocery money. If the house cannot come to an agreement about groceries or use the money unwisely the grocery shopping will be done by another staff member.
- 39. When you leave the property you are to contact your house leader even if they know ahead of time that you are leaving and you are to contact them when you return. We are to know where you are at all times and if you go somewhere besides your planned outing you must call first! If we show up where you are supposed to be and you are not there you are immediately eligible for discharge.
- 40. IF you wish to leave the property without an approved family member or another resident you must have Life360 on your phone.

By my signature below, I certify that I fully understand these rules and regulations, that I have received a copy of them, that I agree to abide by each and every one, and that failure to do so may result in an immediate discharge from Redeemed Living. I also understand that there will be times that rules may be amended, waived, or changed at the discretion of the Staff on an as needed, case by case basis.

Residents away on pass must make it back in time for Sunday evening group and must attend a church service somewhere on Sunday morning and bring back a church bulletin.



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Client's Rights, Responsibilities, Etc.

Redeemed Living is a residential recovery program designed as a continuing care program for individuals whom have already graduated from an in-house treatment program which was a minimum of 28 days in duration.

Redeemed Living maintains a zero-tolerance policy concerning drugs and alcohol. Failure of either a breathalyzer test or a drug test will result in immediate dismissal from the program.

Possible re-entry into the program is handled on a case by case basis including, but not limited to the client's conduct, payment status, and varying circumstances at the time of discharge as well as his conduct after discharge. Generally, there will be a minimum waiting period of thirty days before re-entry will be considered.

If client has a grievance with the policies or procedures of Redeemed Living, they are to address the issue with the live in Administrator first, then if they feel it is not resolved, Brent Moore.

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Voluntary Withdraw Policy

Redeemed Living maintains a zero policy for use of drugs and alcohol. If clients submit a positive urine sample or positive breathalyzer, this action will result in immediate discharge from program, and client will have 1 hour to leave Redeemed Living property. If client relapses while in Redeemed Living or voluntarily withdraws and relapses after withdrawal, he will be required to complete an in-house treatment program lasting at least 30 days prior to being considered for re admission. Director must be satisfied with client's desire to fully participate and comply with programs regulations. Client will also be required to develop an action plan with the director. This policy is in no way negotiable. Final decisions about reentry are at the director's discretion. Effective immediately upon becoming a resident.
